**Agenda Items**

1. Approval of minutes from February 1, 2017 meeting.
  - i. Minutes approved
2. Consider application for SOC 333 for the LL attribute of Gender.
  - i. Course approved
3. Continue consideration of questions from English Department (begun at prior meeting).
  - a. Do courses with the CWR prefix satisfy the LVPA requirement (similar to 1-unit courses with the LIT prefix)?
    - i. Kit Murphy and Kevin Michels will schedule a meeting with representatives from the English Department to obtain additional background information before asking the LLPC to consider the issue.
  - b. Can a 0.5-unit course satisfy the LVPA requirement? Note: The English department is not in favor of this approach.
    - i. LLPC agreed that a 0.5-unit course should not satisfy the LVPA requirement.
  - c. Can two 0.5-unit courses satisfy the LVPA requirement?
    - i. LLPC approved the motion that two 0.5-unit courses with the LIT prefix will satisfy the LVPA requirement provided that the English Department ensures that each 0.5-unit LIT course satisfies all of the LVPA outcomes (so the two half-courses in tandem will provide the depth and sustained attention that will satisfy the LVPA domain).
4. Continue consideration of ECE/ELE113 proposal for LL LVPA designation (begun at prior meeting).
  - i. Course not approved.
5. Consider applications for Quantitative Reasoning designation for POL 200 and ECO 105.
