

## **CAP's Final Recommendation on Academic Integrity Procedural Standards**

### **Background:**

In March 2017 CAP received a charge from the Steering Committee to review the relevant language in Section III of the Academic Integrity Procedural Standards to determine whether the language should be changed to improve clarity. This charge was in response to a letter from 22 faculty members in the School of Humanities and Social Sciences raising a concern about the clarity of the language in the Academic Integrity Procedural Standards. The faculty requested that the Academic Integrity Officer be required to invite individual(s) who submit a complaint to present their case in person.

### **Charge:**

The Steering committee charged CAP to review the relevant language in Section III of the Academic Integrity Procedural Standards to determine whether the language should be changed to improve clarity. If CAP determined that the language should be changed, then CAP was charged to develop a recommendation concerning new language.

### **Final Recommendation:**

After careful discussion, CAP determined that the language in the Academic Integrity Procedural Standards did not need revision, and that the event that resulted in the request to Steering to review the Standards is more appropriately handled on a school level. The committee felt that the existing language in the document is satisfactory.
