

CSCC Report to Steering
May 15, 2017

CSCC completed its Final Recommendation on the Protection of Children Policy, which was approved by Steering in February. We also continued our work on the Student Travel Policy in collaboration with Gary Miller in the Office of Compliance. A Preliminary Recommendation on the Student Travel Policy was distributed to the campus community in early May. Campus input is being received through open fora in May and via a Qualtrics survey. In addition, we continued our work on the Involuntary Health or Safety Withdrawal Policy in collaboration with Angela Lauer Chong. CSCC also discussed the procedures currently used to evaluate applications for the Student Affairs scholarships and Engagement Mini-Grants and voted to add a member of the Staff Senate to the selection committee. Finally, we began work on a new charge to consider the possibility of a Tobacco-Free Campus Policy and plan to solicit input from the campus community in early fall, 2017.
